

Which is Quicker? – 3Gun

START POSITION:

Rifle start: Standing in either box, rifle is loaded at low ready.

Pistol start: Standing in either box, pistol is loaded and holstered.

STAGE PROCEDURE

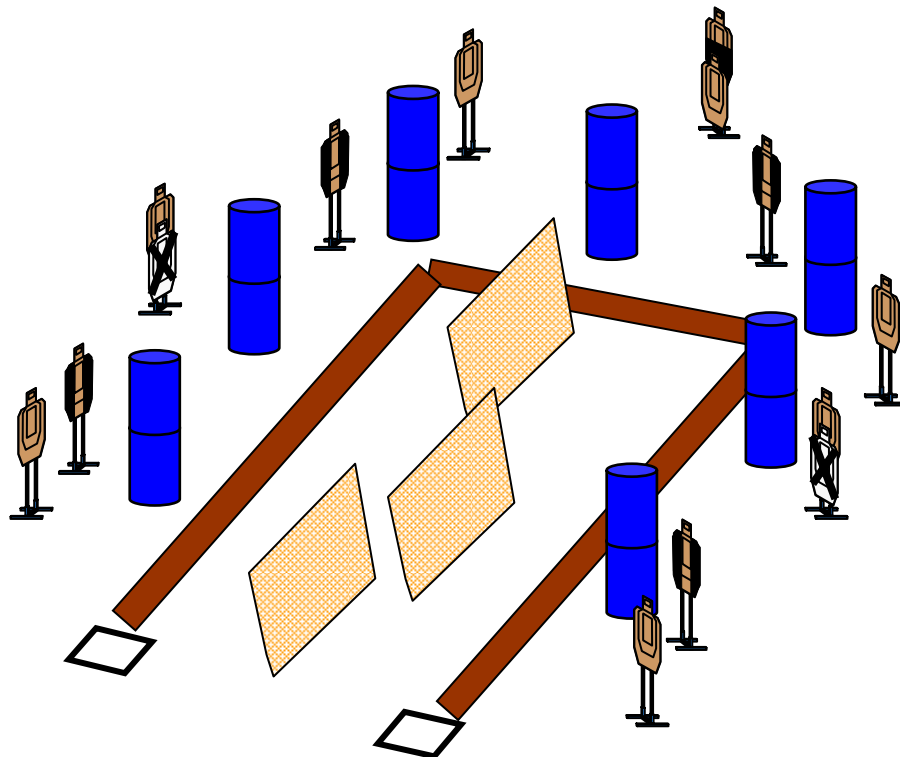
At the signal engage targets as they become visible, while remaining on planks.

All shots fired must be while on planks. Each shot fired while not on planks will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired. One procedural penalty for every step taken off the board to gain an advantage.

This will be recorded as two separate stages with targets scored and taped between strings. Pistol will be shot first.

SCORING

TARGETS: 12 IPSC
ROUND COUNT: 24 rifle (if engaged twice)
24 pistol (if engaged twice)
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: As per current Wisconsin 3-Gun Rules
