

Zig or Zag

RULES: Wisconsin 3-Gun Rules

COURSE DESIGNER: Dirk Hagenah

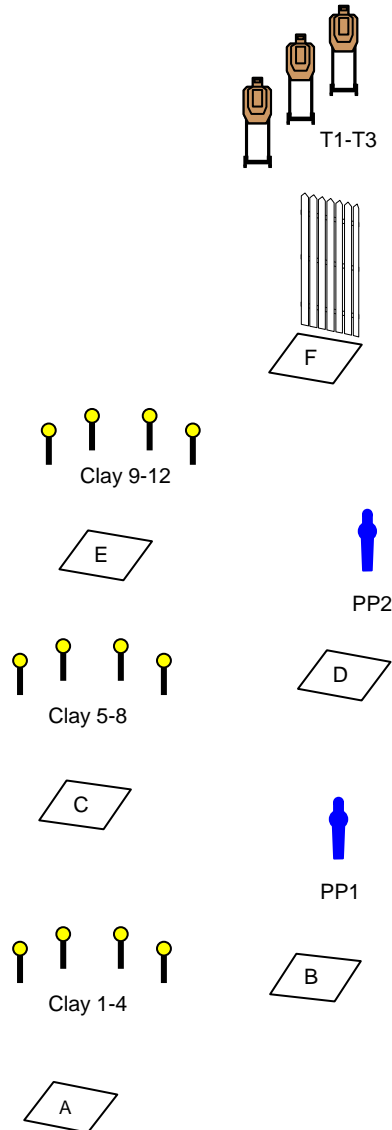
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, shotgun loaded at low ready.

STAGE PROCEDURE

At the signal, engage Clay 1-4, move to Box B and engage PP1, move Box C engage Clay 5-8, move to Box D engage PP2, move to Box E engage Clay 9-12, move to Box F engage T1-T3 with slugs.

SCORING

TARGETS: 3 IPSC, 12 clays, 2 PP
ROUND COUNT: 20 rounds (14 birdshot, 6 slugs)
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: As per current Wisconsin 3-Gun Rules



NOTES:

Must be in boxes to engage appropriate targets.
Slugs at clays or steel will result in DQ.

RO NOTES:

Maintain target and prop position integrity throughout the match.
